

Here is the list of the tools needed in order to complete the course. All of these tools can be purchased as a 'kit' from Jewellers Academy while stocks last.

Week 1 - Sawing, Filing and Drilling Metal

• Use the practice copper & Brass

Week 2 - Silver Jewellery Workshop

- Silver sheet 0.7mm thick 3cm x 3cm for pendant
- Silver sheet 1mm thick, 10mm wide and 8cm long for ring

Week 3 - Soldering Masterclass

- 150 x150mm copper sheet
- 0.8mm and 1mm copper wire from general use

Week 4 - Jigsaw Project

Copper and brass sheets 50mm x50mm

Week 5 - Domed Silver Earrings and Spinner Ring

- Earrings: Silver sheet: $2.5cm \times 2.5cm \times 1mm$ thick $\times 2$
- Earrings: Silver Wire: 0.8mm wire x 20cm long
- Spinner Ring: 1.5mm thick sterling silver wire round 10cm long
- Spinner Ring: 0.7mm thick sterling silver sheet, 8cm long, 12mm wide

Week 7 - Stone setting - Cabochon setting

- D shape wire 2.3mm x 1.5mm silver wire, 80mm Length
- ullet Fine silver Bezel strip- 5.0mm x 0.3mm, 40mm Length
- Silver Sheet 15mm x 15mm, 0.6mm thick
- Cabochon Gemstone 10mm round

Week 8 - Tube and Flush Setting

- Silver Tube, Outside Diameter 5.5mm, Inside Diameter 4.2mm, 0.65mm Wall Thickness 6mm length x2 pieces
- 5mm round CZ x 2
- 1.5mm Round silver wire, 8cm
- 1.5mm Beaded wire, 8cm silver (for tube set ring project)
- Flush setting: 2mm CZ stones x 6
- Flush setting: Silver Sheet: 2mm thick x 20mm x 10mm

Week 9 - Cold connections: Hinges (book project) and

Rivets

- Book: Sheet Silver, 25mm x 25mm, thickness 1mm (x 2)
- Book: Tube Silver, 2.4mm outside diameter, 1.6mm inside diameter x 28mm length
- Book: Silver wire, 1.5mm thick, length 30mm
- Rivet: Silver Sheet 20mm x 20mm, thickness 0.7mm thick
- Rivet: Silver Tube 1.4mm Outside Diameter, Inside diameter 0.9mm length
 20mm

Week 10 - Wax Carving Level 1

- Blue Ring stick 1/2 (or full) flat top
- Pendant/ Charm x1 slice of blue wax (block slices 3-6mm)

Week 1 - Wedding Rings

- Wishbone: D-shape 2.3 x 1.5mm thick silver wire, 80mm long
- Plain band: D-shape 3mm x 2mm, 9ct Yellow gold, 80mm long
- Solder 9ct gold hard (cut small piece out of panel)

Week 2 - Irregular Cab Setting

- Fine Silver Bezel Strip, 5mm tall x 18cm length
- Silver Sheet, 0.8mm thick, 45mm x 35mm

Week 3 - Torque Bangle

- silver d-shaped wire, 40cm length, 3mm x 2mm
- silver tube, Outside Diameter 2.4mm, Inside Diameter 1.6mm, 0.4mm Wall Thickness 30mm Length
- silver wire, 1.2mm thick, 10cm long
- silver sheet, 0.8mm thick, 30 x 40mm
- cabochon stone dimensions to fit within 30×40 mm sheet, (needs to be oval shape)
- fine silver bezel wire 5mm tall, 24cm long



Week 4 - Stone Setting in Wax

- 4mm round CZ
- 8mm cabochon stone
- Use leftover wax from Term 1

Week 5 - Collet Setting

- 5.5mm CZ Stones x 2
- Sheet Silver for setting 0.7mm thick, 40mm x 40mm
- Silver for a ring round wire 1.5mm thick, 80mm long

Week 7 & 8 - Make a Silver Box

- 8.5cm Length x 1cm 0.8mm thick sterling silver sheet X2
- 8.5cm Length x 1cm 0.5mm thick sterling silver sheet X1
- 3.5cm square 0.6mm thick silver sheet X2

Week 9 - Working with Gold

- 9ct Yellow Gold wire, 1.5mm thick, round, 16cm long
- Gold casting grain nugget x 1 (Suggest order from CooksonGold)
- Silver wire, round, 1.5mm thick, 16cm long
- Gold tube: 3mm outside, 2.1mm inside diameter. 8mm length (tube gets cut in half for both rings)
- Real Gemstone, 2.5mm round faceted stone

Week 1 - Chain Making

- Round Silver Wire, 1.5mm thick, 60cm
- Round Gold Wire, 0.8mm thick (or 1mm), 25cm
- Twisted chain, silver wire, 1mm round, 90cm
- Clasp: 1.5mm silver square wire, 5cm long
- Clasp: 1.5mm silver round wire, 7cm long
- · Random chain, 1mm thick silver wire, 20cm

Week 2 - Claw Setting

- silver tube, outside diameter 5.5mm, 6mm long
- silver wire, round, 0.8mm thick x 20cm
- Round faceted Stone 5mm
- Silver Round wire, 2mm thick, 8cm long

Week 3 - Stone Setting and Soldering - Using Cast Settings

- Pendant: 2 x pear-shaped stones 10x7mm fancy cut
- Pendant: 2 x pear shaped claw settings for 10x8mm
- Pendant: 6 x 3mm round faceted stones, brilliant cut
- Pendant: 6 x round 4-claw settings for stones 3.5mm
- Pendant: 1.2mm silver wire x 12cm
- Ring: 3.5mm x 4 round setting claws
- Ring: 3mm x 4 round faceted stones, brilliant cut
- Ring: 5.5mm x 2 round setting claws
- Ring: 5mm x 2 round faceted stones, brilliant cut
- Ring: silver wire, 1.5mm round, 8cm

Note: if you are ordering your own cast settings we strongly recommend measuring the size of the cast baskets BEFORE ordering your stones to ensure you get the correct fit

Week 4 - Granulation in Silver

- Pendant: Oval Cabochon stone for pendant approx. 15mm x 20mm
- Pendant: 0.7mm thick silver sheet 30mm x 20mm
- Pendant: 0.6mm thick silver sheet for bail, 5mm x 150mm
- Pendant: 1mm round silver wire for bail, 3cm long
- Silver wire for making spheres 0.8mm x 120cm
- Ring: D-shaped wire, 3mm x 2mm, 8cm long
- Ring: 2.5mm round brilliant-cut gemstone, suggest CZ
- Ring: Tube with inside diameter 2.1mm, outside 3mm, 6mm long
- Silver wire for making spheres 0.8mm x 100cm

Week 5 - Silver Metal Clay 1: Charms and Pendant

- 10g Art Clay Silver
- Silver bracelet chain and clasp

Week 6 - Metal Clay 2: Working with Gold

- 10g Art Clay Silver
- 1 x yellow gold casting grain (suggest buy from CooksonGold)
- 1 x square of 24K gold leaf (for Keum-boo)



Week 7 - Beading: Gemstone & Wire Jewellery

- Nylon wire 0.25mm
- Silver wire round 0.4mm x 3 metres
- Briolette beads x 4 in total (including 1 earring pair 5-8mm, 1 for bracelet 5-8mm & 1 for pendant 8mm) Suggestion buy from Etsy or Kernowcraft
- Selection of small gemstone beads for cluster pendant, cluster earring pair & 3 x stacking bracelets. Breakdown to buy:- x3 strands of gemstone beads (2.5mm-4mm) a few 3mm freshwater pearls
- Findings, Silver crimps x 10, 1.5x1.5mm
- Findings, Silver lobster clasp x 4
- Findings, Silver closed jump rings 6mm (0.7mm THIN) (for clasp) x 4
- Findings, Silver open jump rings 6mm (for earrings) x 4
- Findings, Silver jump ring for pendant, x 1 open and 1 closed
- Findings, Silver ball end headpins x 25
- 0.8mm thick round wire 20cm length (for ear wires)

When purchasing stones, we suggest choosing cubic zirconias. They are more affordable and hard to damage while you are practicing your technique!
