


Introducing the *new* Advanced Jewellery Diploma from Jewellers Academy which has been designed as the third year follow on course from the Diploma in Fine Jewellery.


This Diploma is for intermediate to advanced-level jewellers excited to hone their skills and continue their jewellery-making journey.

# WEEKS 4 TO 5 Eternity Band (Half) - Split Claw Setting Technique

Learn how to make a traditional 7 stone, half band eternity ring.

#### Cluster Earrings - Back Plate and Claw Set WEEKS 6 TO 8 with Granulation

This week you will learn how to make a gorgeous pair of cluster earrings which combines a few different techniques including claw setting and granulation.

#### **Hollow Hinged Bangle** WEEKS 3 TO 5

An advanced construction project. Discover how to make a hollow bangle with a small hinge and intricate clasp. A real challenge for advanced level jewellers.

#### Halo Setting - Pavé and Claw Setting WEEKS 6 TO 7

You guessed it! More stone setting. Learn to create a classical halo setting. Combining pave and claw settings to make this statement cluster of stones, taught by master stone setter Scott McIntyre.

#### Filigree with Gold - Advanced Project **WEEKS 8 TO 9**


Learn from expert filigree artist Michelle Lierre, create a filigree ring with gold and incorporating a central stone. A stunning statement piece.
