



Considered the second year in our Diploma series here at Jewellers Academy, the Diploma in Fine Jewellery is a year-long course designed to take you to the next level.


You will learn new jewellery-making skills that are enjoyable and fulfilling to master and will also help you to create commercial, highly desirable fine jewellery.

#### Reticulation and Keum Boo -WEEK 1 Stud Earrings and Ring Making

Learn how to apply gold accents and texture to your work using the ancient Korean technique of Keum Boo.

#### Claw Setting Practice Week - Round, Oval, WEEK 2 Pear, Cushion Cut

Practice your claw making skills this week and learn how to make settings for four key stone shapes.

#### **Claw Setting Project** WEEK 3

This week is all about putting the previous weeks skills into practice to make a pair or drop earrings.









#### WFFK 4 Pear Shaped Collet (Making a Ring or Pendant)

Learn how to make a classic, pear shaped collet using two different techniques, a tapered side collet and a straight side collet.

# WEEKS 5 TO 6 Collet Setting Project: Totem Pendant with Three Collet Settings

In this project you will build on the collet setting that you completed last week to make a piece with multiple collet settings.

### WEEKS 7 TO 8 Rendering: Painting Fine Jewellery

Jewellery rendering is the process of creating a realistic representation of a piece of jewellery. It can be used as part of your design process, on your website or selling platform and to showcase a final design for a commission customer.

Finding Making for Fine Jewellery: Scroll Back Earrings, Toggle Clasp & More

The ability to make your own findings can really help to elevate your jewellery work. In this project you will learn to make a good range of findings suitable for fine jewellery.





#### **Gemstone Masterclass**

Learn the basics of gemmology to help you as a fine jeweller with buying, using gemstones in your designs and sharing your knowledge with your customers.

### Advanced Stone Setting in Wax

Learn how to stone set in wax using the cast in place technique. The course will cover 3 different settings - a pave setting, a channel setting as well as how to use granulation to secure stones in place.

#### Making a Classic Tennis Bracelet

This style of bracelet is a multi-linked bracelet with lots of stones exactly the same size and a clasp in whichever style you choose. You will learn how to create the hidden links and rivets that form this style of bracelet.



#### Marquise 5 Stone Ring Setting WEEKS 6 TO 8

This course will focus on more stone setting and multiple, complex solder joins to help expand your knowledge and confidence when it comes to making rings with multiple settings.

#### Box Clasp: Advanced Techniques for Jewellers

Learn how to design and make the perfect box clasp for stringing pearls or beads. You can adapt the design to hold multiple strands or you can solder on a jump ring to allow you to use this it in other jewellery designs.





### Creole Earrings: Two Types of Hinged **Earrings**

This week you will learn how to make two different types of classic creole, hinged hoop earrings.

#### WEEKS 1TO 2

#### Using Gravers & Star Stone Setting Locket Making

Learn how to use gravers to create star stone settings in a pendant and a bangle.

WEEKS 3 TO 4

Learn how to make a classic oval or circular locket with a working hinge and a little lip on the outer edge so that you can easily open and close the locket.

WEEKS 5 TO 6

#### A Statement Fine Jewellery **Diamond Cluster Ring**

Learn how to make this stunning statement cluster ring which brings together many of your new jewellery making skills including claw setting, tube setting, piercing and soldering.

#### WEEK 8

#### Filigree for Jewellers

Learn the art of filigree and using wire to create intricate designs.

# Tully supported learning


